

## Dear Parents/Guardians:

Project Alpha is a seminar program that was founded by Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. and the March of Dimes. The seminar/conference provides an environment where young males can learn about sexuality, manhood and relationship issues. Young males will receive information on problem-solving skills and share their own experiences in an all-male setting. The target audience is young men in the age range of 12 to 17 years old.

Brothers of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated will serve as role models and facilitators of the conference. During the conference, participants will receive information about HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases, teen pregnancy prevention, and abstinence/virginity. Due to the sensitive nature of the contents of the seminar, all conference participants under the age of 18 must obtain the consent of their parent or guardian in order to attend and participate in the seminar.



Resource persons will discuss the following topics during the conference:

- Male Health Issues and Guidance for Sexually Active Male Teens
- Self-esteem, Teen Violence and Good Citizenship for the Male Teens
- HIV/AIDS Education and Sexually Transmitted Diseases
- Legal Obligations of the Male Teen Parent and Impact on His Future
- The seminar will include interactive group sessions

The Seminar will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2013, between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at the Louisiana Prevention Training Center. The conference is sponsored jointly by the Baton Rouge AIDS Society and Chapters of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. If transportation is necessary, I agree that my son can ride in vehicles owned or rented by the Alpha brothers. I fully understand that during the conference, participants will discuss issues related to sexuality and relationships, such as HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases, teen pregnancy, and abstinence/ virginity.
